

Anime Japan (TAJ)

Anime Japan formerly known as Tokyo International Anime Fair is one of the biggest anime fairs worldwide. It is held every year in spring in Tokyo and has over 100,000 visitors. There are 270 exhibitors – 55 of them from foreign countries. There you can watch the newest anime or learn how they are made. Aside from that, there are also many exciting events – so don't miss it!

Comiket (COM)

The Comiket takes place in summer and winter. Comiket is an abbreviation that stands for Comic Market. And that's what you will mostly find there: Japanese comics or doujinshi to be more precise. You can find many drawing talents there, that are yet to be discovered. If you are lucky you could buy a manga from one of the famous talents of tomorrow! It is also THE place to show and see passion for cosplay – short for costume play. If you ever wanted to see Japanese cosplay this is your chance!

Tokyo Game Show (TGS)

Every year in September you can get to know the newest video games for PC and consoles at the Tokyo Game Show (short: TGS). It's all about new games and new technical equipment. If you are interested in video games here's your chance to be one of the first, who takes a look at some of the many new games.

World Cosplay Summit (WCS)

At this annual event you can watch cosplayers from all over the world in their hand made and colourful costumes. Each of them is lavish and extravagant and shows how much effort the cosplayer put into making them. They spend weeks and months to finish their costume only to be able to participate in this event.

Halloween (HAL)

Halloween celebration swept across the ocean and is steadily growing in Japan. Various parades and costume events as well as the biggest Halloween Gathering ever seen will get you into a splendid scary mood in October.

Ryokan

This is a traditional Japanese hotel. There are some rules to respect such as taking off your shoes before entering. The floor is covered with tatami mats on which you can sit and eat or sleep on a so called futon.

Kimono

This is traditional Japanese clothing. In Kyoto, you can watch a kimono fashion show or try to wear one. The kimono we know today has been established in the 8th century.

Capsule Hotel

This is a typical and original Japanese hotel. It was developed in 1979 in Japan and consists of extremely small "rooms" (capsules).

Osaka

Modern industrial city of the 21st century. There is a huge shopping mall and a big ferris wheel with a height of 112m. The Umeda Sky Building with a height of 173m overlooks the city. Osaka Castle is also an emblematic monument, as well as Osaka Public Aquarium, which is famous for its whale sharks.

Tokyo

Capital of Japan. Here you can find several temples and shrines like Sensoji in Asakusa or the Meiji shrine in Shibuya. Where Shibuya is the Mecca for all those who like fashion, Akihabara and Nakano will primarily attract all technological enthusiasts, as well as manga and anime fans. Odaiba features a famous Gundam statue and a beach, while Harajuku is home for Tokyos Gothic Lolitas.
